## **Celebrating our 12th Anniversary**

We first launched 3D InCites at SEMICON West in 2009. So, this time of year, I find myself reflecting on where we've been and where we're going next. One thing I learned from 2020/2021, is that because we've always been a virtual platform, the pandemic didn't slow us down much. We published our <a href="Yearbook">Yearbook</a> on a digital platform that was even cooler than print because you could place videos as ads – (kind of like the newspapers in Harry Potter.) It's also more sustainable than printing 5000 copies. We'll probably keep doing it this way.

Our membership has grown steadily to 46 members, and we keep adding ways to help them tell their stories. We launched 3D InCites on the <u>WeChat</u> platform, giving us a presence in China. We also launched the <u>3D InCites Podcast</u> in May. I'm excited to report that in the first two months, we've had more
